Course Description:

Only Fools Run at Midnight, a three-mile fun run to benefit the Muscular Dystrophy Association in Alaska, starting at Twin Lakes and finishing at the Juneau Fire Station. Seven dollars, registration at 11 p.m., glow sticks handed out just before the start, and four-colour t-shirts for the first 150 to register. Prizes went to the top finishers in three classes - kids 4 to 12, men and women, and masters men and women over 50 - and for the best costume. The grand prize, for the most pledges sold, was a trip for two to Copenhagen. Sponsored by the Juneau area-wide fire departments with the Juneau Medical Center, Juneau Travel, Scandinavian Airlines, the Juneau Empire, TAKU 105 and KJNO. Recorded from the advertisement; no results are known. The advertisement reads "Saturday, August 22 ... at midnight", and the race is filed on that Saturday rather than in the small hours of the Sunday, which is how the site's other runnings are recorded.

If allowed by the Race Director, and if I am pushing a baby jogger or stroller, I also accept the responsibility for injury up to death of the child being transported in the jogger or stroller. Having read this waiver and knowing these facts and in consideration of your accepting my entry, I, for myself and anyone entitled to act on my behalf, waive and release the Juneau Trail and Road Runners, the United States Forest Service, the state of Alaska, the City and Borough of Juneau, and the Road Runners Club of America, all event sponsors, their representatives and successors from all claims or liabilities of any kind arising out of my participation in this event, even though that liability may arise out of negligence or carelessness on the part of the persons named in this waiver. In addition, I acknowledge the contagious nature of communicable diseases and voluntarily assume the risk that I may be exposed to or infected by communicable diseases by participating in this event. I acknowledge that such exposure or infection may result in personal injury, illness, permanent disability, and/or death. I grant permission to all of the foregoing to use my photographs, motion pictures, recordings or any other record of this event for any legitimate purposes.
